Primary Badge

The Built on XRP Ledger badge must be consistently applied with a transparency background (png, svg, eps)

Logo modifications compromise the XRPL brand. Please do not attempt to recreate or alter the Built on XRPL logo.


Badge Variations

The Built on XRP Ledger badge has both a horizontal and vertical lockup. Horizontal is preferred but when the primary badge doesn't fit your composition, use the vertical lockup.


Horizontal Lockup: Preferred

On light backgrounds, use the black badge.



On dark backgrounds, use the white badge.

Black and white versions for print or any colorless design guidelines.

On dark backgrounds, use the white badge.





Badge Misuse

The XRPL badge cannot be used to represent anything other than the XRPL badge itself. The badge must not be altered in any fashion.



Do not alter the color



Do not manipulate the badge



Do not remove the pattern



Do not add content or remove any parts
